Training Package 1

Mandatory Combined General Evacuation and Fire Extinguisher Training

Duration: 1.5 hours

General Evacuation Instructions (Occupant Training)

Annual training for all personnel in the workplace. This session is a brief instruction to all staff covering the response of employees to an emergency in the workplace.

First Response and Extinguisher Training

Training for all building occupants to attend. This training course provides participants with the required knowledge to be able to correctly identify and select the most suitable first attack firefighting equipment which is typically available in the workplace.

Participants undertake theoretical training which will provide an understanding of:

- What a fire is and how to respond
- How to assess the type and size of the fire and therefore select appropriate measures and equipment for first attack.

Training Package 2

Mandatory Combined Warden, General Evacuation and Fire Extinguisher Training

Duration: 2 hours

Evacuation Coordination Instructions (Warden Training)

Annual training for your nominated Evacuation Coordinators (Wardens). This training to ensure they are consistently up to date with current changes in both the Regulations and Australian Standards and to have a full understanding of how to operate as part of an Emergency Control Organisation (ECO).
